Vermont Health Connect Numbers



- Accounts Created: 21,794
- Plan Selection, Individuals
 - QHP: 5,173
 - Medicaid: 2,181
- Employees: 3,914

Enrollment Timeline Changes



- Deadline for enrollment extended to December 23
 - Plan selection must be completed by December 23 for January coverage
 - Payment must be postmarked January 7th for January 1 (retroactive) coverage
- 2015 Open Enrollment dates changed
 - November 15, 2015 – January 15, 2015

Premium Processing for Individuals & Families

- Scheduled for deployment overnight (December 2)
- Changes include:
 - Updated Payment Confirmation Pages after Plan Selection
 - Payment Method and Address Confirmation
- Functionality at “go live”
 - Bills will be sent based on indicated preference
 - Payment method initially limited to “payment by check”

Premium Processing for Small Businesses

- Functionality not yet available on Vermont Health Connect
- Contingency plan deployed December 2nd
 - All VHC Small Businesses will have their 2013 health plan extended until Premium Processing for small business is functional (up to March 31)

Premium Processing for Small Businesses

- Outreach includes phone calls, email and USPS notices to Small Businesses that:
 - Enrolled in Vermont Health Connect
 - Notified carrier of intent to drop coverage
 - Were offering coverage for the first time through VHC
 - Notified carrier of intent to enroll in VHC but do not appear on VHC List

2015 VHC Qualified Health Plans



- General Overview
 - QHP designs recommended by DVHA, approved by GMCB
 - Plans (forms) certified by DFR; rates approved by GMCB
 - DVHA selects and contracts from among certified plans
- 2015 QHPs
 - ACA - same Essential Health Benefits package (services)
 - VT flexibility with plan design/cost-sharing structure
 - Guides: learning what Vermonters prefer, calendar
- Proposing 2015 plan design adjustments to GMCB
 - Specialist office visits; pediatric dental; and couples tier
