
What are we trying to do through this project?

- Create/accelerate three things, on a statewide, all-payer basis:
 - An integrated system of value-based provider payment
 - Shared savings arrangements with accountable care organizations
 - Episode of care payments
 - Pay-for-performance
 - An integrated system of care coordination and care management
 - An integrated system of electronic health records

How will we do it?

- Input through 7 work groups on policy and spending
- Recommendations:
 - work groups → steering committee → core team → policies of GMCB, AHS, DVHA, private payers and providers
- On what?
 - Coordinated policy:
 - Payment
 - Care management
 - Health information exchange
 - Other federally-supported initiatives
 - Dual eligible demonstration
 - Blueprint for Health
 - Global Commitment and Choices for Care
 - Targeted funding:
 - Modeling and testing payment reforms
 - Expanding health information exchange
 - Supporting providers to change their business models
