30 Medicaid for Children and Adults (MCA) has no resource test.

32 **5% Disregard § 28.03(c)(4):**

33 The 5% disregard is ONLY applied to the highest income test the individual qualifies for AND ONLY if it will make them eligible.

34 The 5% disregard does NOT apply to Dr. Dynasaur premiums or APTC or CSR.

36 **MCA SPENDDOWNS § 28.04:**

37 - Individuals who ONLY meet the new adult category at 7.03(a)(5) and are over the 133% income test are ineligible for MCA Medicaid due to excess income AND are NOT allowed to "spend down".

39 - Spenddowns ARE allowed for pregnant women who fail the 208% FPL and children under 19 who fail the 312% FPL. If so, they must spend down to the applicable PIL.

40 - Spenddowns ARE allowed for parents or caretaker relatives who fail the applicable Parent/CR standard and the 133%.

41 - If the parent or caretaker relative fails the maximum income allowed for a parent/CR, if they qualify for adult criteria at 7.03(a)(5), go to the maximum income allowed for adult 133% FPL. If they meet the adult criteria but fail the 133% test, then

42 compare to the 133% + 5% disregard FPL. If they fail both the parent/CR and the 133% + 5% test, and they request a spenddown, calculate the spenddown using the PIL.
