## Open Enrollment 2024: Providing More Affordable Health Insurance for Many Vermonters

Open Enrollment is here! From November 1 – December 15, 2023, you can enroll in a health or dental plan that **begins January 1, 2024**. Additionally, you can enroll sign up between December 16, 2023 – January 15, 2024, for a plan that **begins February 1, 2024**.

If you are looking to get health insurance, you may qualify for lower cost insurance when you enroll with Vermont Health Connect. Over 90% of people who are enrolled through the health insurance marketplace qualify for financial help. Vermonters in single plans may now qualify for financial help with incomes up to \$134,000. Those in family plans may qualify with incomes up to \$376,000.

If you are currently enrolled in a qualified health plan, now is the time for you to **update your information** with Vermont Health Connect (VHC). Sign in to your account at <a href="https://www.VermontHealthConnect.com">www.VermontHealthConnect.com</a> or call -855-899-9600 as soon as possible. Review your information and report any changes right away to be sure you are getting the right amount of financial help.

The main form of financial help comes as a premium tax credit. If eligible, you can take the tax credit in advance as a discount on your monthly health insurance premium. Or you can get it all when you file your taxes. You can **only** get the premium tax credit if you sign up through VHC.

Vermonters may save even more money by changing health plans. To help with plan selection, VHC's 2024 <u>Plan Comparison Tool</u> can help! The tool helps you choose a plan that best meets your financial and medical needs. It also estimates how much financial help you may get.
