If you have health insurance through Vermont Health Connect, we need to know when you have certain changes in your life.





Weddings, births, new jobs, raises, and other changes can impact your health insurance choices and your costs. If these changes aren't reported, you could end up owing money back at tax time.

If you receive—or are interested in receiving—financial help to make health insurance more affordable, some common life changes you should report include:

- A change in job or income
- Getting married or divorced
- Moving
- Having a child or adopting a child
- A change in immigration status
- Gaining or losing a dependent
- Getting health coverage through a job or a program like Medicare or TRICARE
